




The Chinese Government Attaches Great Importance to IP

- Refine the systems underpinning the market economy, such as those for property rights protection, in order to improve the business environment



Outline to Build China into a Strong IP Country (2021-2035)







A "strict, extensive, fast and equal" IP protection system




Social Satisfaction Survey with IP Protection in 2012-2022






